Reciprocal Emergency Water Sales Agreement between KCMO and Johnson County, KS	11/1/2018

Reason
Need to establish terms and conditions for supplying water in emergency conditions between KCMO and Water One.

Details

Reason for Legislation
Establishes a reciprocal emergency water services agreement between Kansas City, Missouri and Water District #1 of Johnson County, Kansas for when there is a temporary inability of either party to provide essential water service to its water customers through its existing water distribution systems.
As the largest water utilities in the Kansas City metropolitan area, both KC Water and Water One recognize the need for a reciprocal emergency water services agreement between their respective water utilities. This ordinance will establish an agreement for each utility to provide emergency water services to the other utility. The agreement defines "Emergency Conditions", where interconnections exist along State Line Road, how the parties shall notify one another when an emergency condition occurs, metering and pricing of emergency water, and maintenance responsibilities for equipment at the interconnection points.
This agreement shall be in effect through May 1, 2023 and then automatically renew thereafter for successive one year terms on the anniversary date of May 1st upon the same terms and conditions contained in the agreement for a period of no more than twenty (20) years.
