Executive Summary

Authorizing the Director of the Aviation Department to enter into a \$5,100,000.00 Amendment #8 to a Tenant Reimbursement Agreement with Trammell Crow Kansas City Development, Inc. for the Commerce Center Development at the KCI Airport; for a total contract amount of \$34,300,082.97; appropriating \$5,100,000.00 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Kansas City Aviation Fund.

Discussion

The Aviation Department, in conjunction with Trammell Crow Kansas City Development, is developing the KCI Intermodal Business Centre. The project comprises of a 620-acre site defined within the Master Development Agreement. The site is located just south of 112th Street and I-29 at Kansas City International Airport.

The original Tenant Reimbursement Agreement with Trammell Crow, Ordinance No. 070157, effective March 4, 2007, for \$15,164,043, provided for the design, construction and construction monitoring services for site grading, utilities, etc. for a 183 acre parcel of land out of a proposed 640 acre site development.

Amendment 1, executed March 3, 2010, and Amendment 2, executed January 21, 2013, revised the term of the agreement.

Amendment 3, ordinance #141006, effective December 11, 2014, authorized the addition of \$1,743,807.06 for continuing construction services.

Amendment 4, ordinance #170037, effective January 26, 2017, authorized the addition of \$1,500,000.00 for continuing construction services.

Amendment 5, ordinance #190041 effective February 7, 2019, authorized the addition of \$2,000,000 for continuing construction services

Amendment 6, ordinance #191039 effective December 22, 2019, authorized the addition of \$8,000,000 for continuing construction services

Amendment 7 authorized the addition of \$792,232.91 for continuing construction services


