Reason for Legislation

To increase appropriations in order to complete more units than expected due to above average temperatures lengthening the construction season. The requested amount will total \$160,000.00 to fund repair of lead paint hazards and health and safety issues in low income single and multi-family homes of families with young children.

Funding for this project is from the Kansas City Health Department, U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Lead Hazard Control Grant. This funding provides free lead hazard control services to low income property owners who have lead paint hazards in their properties. This program provides lead-safe housing to Kansas City families with young children and pregnant women. This project will create 172 lead-safe residences and improve housing for 275 residents over the course of the project.
