<p>Discussion <i>(including relationship to other Council actions)</i> This ordinance will approve the City’s annual contract with the KCATA for legal services. The City Attorney’s Office will handle tort litigation, as well as certain property damage claims for the KCATA during the one-year period from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.
