**Discussion**

This ordinance authorizes the First Amendment to the Water Purchase Agreement between the City Kansas City, Missouri and Clay County Public Water Supply District #8 and Council Approval is required under Chapter 3, Section 41 of the Code of Ordinances that requires Council approval for any cooperative agreement on behalf of the City for more than 6 years. Clay County PWSD #8 has been a long time Wholesale water customer of the City of Kansas City, Missouri
