<p>Reason for Legislation The Municipal Art Commission, in consultation with the City Planning and Development Department, requests the City Council dispense with the Commission's approval of certain structures encroaching upon City property so that the Commission may focus its attention on its duties as the principal advisory arm of the city in matters of design and visual elements of major public buildings, structures, and art objects, and in matters of promoting, fostering and encouraging cultural activities of all kinds, including the fine arts and performing arts.</p> <p>The structures outlined in the Ordinance are: blade signs with a face area not exceeding 12 sq. ft., awnings, balconies, fire escapes, retaining walls, patios, accessibility ramps, and any doors which shall extend upon any street, avenue, highway, park or property belonging to the City. The City Planning and Development Department will retain approval authority for projects that do not include significant aesthetic considerations, such as blade signs with a face area not exceeding 12 sq. ft., awnings, balconies, fire escapes, retaining walls, patios, accessibility ramps, and any doors which shall extend upon any street, avenue, highway, park or property belonging to the City. Such structures will still require review by the City Planning and Development Department.
