# Entrepreneurial Support Organizations



Entrepreneur support organizations (ESOs) experience many of the same challenges faced by Kansas City's diverse small business community that stifle their effectiveness. This includes staffing and resource constraints, lack of business education and practical experience, and fragmented systems of support. Without addressing these structural and systemic constraints, enabling equitable and inclusive small business growth will remain an unattainable goal.

Resource Partner Enhancement Program residency to strategically advance the capabilities and capacity of 3–5 BIPOC led entrepreneurial support organizations. Capital support in the form of grants will be provided to the resident organizations to implement new programing and/or advance their existing programing with new staff and technology.
