WHEREAS, the Board under Section 10 of its ByLaws may appoint agents for the District as it shall deem necessary or advisable whom shall serve at the pleasure of the Board;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to create a staff position of Executive Director to serve at the pleasure of the Board;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint the current Project Manager of the UMKC Health Sciences District, Alison Troutwine, to serve as Executive Director of the District; and

WHEREAS, Alison Troutwine, who is employed by University Health, will serve as Executive Director on a voluntary basis without compensation.
