Project Description: The lease is for an advertising display on 2 carousels in the arrival hall at the new Terminal. In addition, there will be installed by Children's Mercy 290 "planes" that will be hung from the arrivals hall ceiling. The term of the lease is for 5 years and 2 months. The lease can be renewed by Director of Aviation for additional one-year periods. The leasee will pay rent equal to \$100,000/year.
