#### **Executive Summary**

Appropriating \$489,303 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Aviation Fund; and authorizing a \$2,348,657 contract with SITA Information Network Computing USA for operation and maintenance service of low-voltage IT systems in the single terminal facility at Kansas City International Airport.

Discussion

This contract with SITA Information Networking Computing USA will provide for operation and maintenance service of low voltage IT systems within the new single terminal facility at Kansas City International Airport.

SITA will provide remote software / application support and all relevant licensing for the following systems:

- SITA CUTE service (SITA Flex Hybrid)
- SITA CUSS kiosk services
- EVIDS (FIDS, GIDS, BIDS, etc.)
- 76 IPTV screens/endpoints (Vitec Global Gold Service Level)
- 20 desk mounted Facepods with Biometrics for US Exit using CBP TVS
- BSM at entire airport for all airlines
- Includes 24x7 CONTRACTOR Service Desk and remote software application support and remote maintenance

This Contract shall begin upon substantial completion of the new terminal facility on or around February 2, 2023 and shall end no later than February 1, 2028.

The maximum amount that City shall pay Contractor under this Contract shall not exceed two million three hundred forty eight thousand six hundred fifty seven dollars (\$2,348,657) as follows:
