### **Executive Summary**

Appropriating \$1,795,434 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Aviation Fund; and authorizing a \$9,230,886 contract with SAAB, Inc. for operation and maintenance service of virtual ramp control systems in the single terminal facility at Kansas City International Airport.

#### **Discussion**

This contract with SAAB, Inc will provide for operation and maintenance service of of virtual ramp control systems in the single terminal facility at Kansas City International Airport.

SAAB will provide the following in support of the virtual ramp control systems:

- professional staff to manage aircraft ground traffic in and out of the MCI single terminal ramps, gates, the Remain Over Night parking locations and deicing operations in corrdination with FAA tower control and aircraft pilots. Professional staff will manage aircraft traffic utilizing the VRC system and tools provided by Saab. Staffing shall include coverage from 0400 to 2400, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
- Aerobahn Surface Management software (SMAN), licensing and hosting, plus user support and customer service support 24x7x365.
- preventative and corrective maintenance of the system. This includes maintenance of the hardware replacement/repair and support, software and program support and infrastructure needed for a fully operational system.

This Contract # 6222090040 shall begin on February 1, 2023 and shall end no later than January 31, 2028.

The maximum amount that City shall pay Contractor under this Contract shall not exceed nine million two hundred thirty thousand eight hundred eighty six dollars (\$9,230,886) as follows:
