# **Executive Summary**

Authorizing a Concession Agreement with Smarte Carte, Inc., Contract No. 6222090042 to provide automated luggage cart services at Kansas City International Airport; estimating revenue in the amount of \$450.00 in the Aviation Fund.

### **Discussion**

Authorizing a five (5) year Concession Agreement, March 1, 2023 through February 29, 2028 with Smarte Carte, Inc. to provide four (4) automated luggage cart machines in the pre-security baggage claim arrival area, and one (1) in the international baggage claim arrival area of the single terminal at Kansas City International Airport. All costs associated with operating and installing the automated luggage cart machines are solely paid for by Smarte Carte, Inc.

Smarte Carte will pay a Concession Fee of either five (5%) of the monthly gross cart rent revenue, or a Minimum Monthly Fee Of \$166.67, the greater of to be deposited in the Aviation Department's General Fund – Terminal Concessions (Other), 8300-620000-470663.

Smarte Cart projects luggage cart rental transactions will average approximately \$2,700 annually over the five-year term in the single terminal facility. Luggage cart rental fees are not to exceed \$7.00 per transaction.

The solicitation was advertised on the City's website October 20, 2022 and the RFP Deadline was 5:00PM on Tuesday, November 22, 2022.

RFP packets were sent to the following ten organizations:

Flight Services and Systems; Expresso Luggage Carts, Global APS USA; WANZL N.A.; Bagport; UFL; Cheersmetal; Carttec; Belclaire Carts; Smarte Carte

One proposal was received before the November 22nd as follows: Smarte Carte, Inc.:

Total Capital Investment of \$108,000



A selection committee consisting of Aviation Deputy Director Melissa Cooper, Assistant Director Pete Fullerton, Councilwoman Melissa Robinson, and Mario Vasquez representing the City Manager's Office recommended to award this concession contract to Smarte Carte, Inc. on December 16, 2022.
