Executive Summary

Approving the petition to terminate the N.W. 97th Terrace & N. Congress Avenue Community Improvement District; terminating the District generally located at N.W. 97th Terrace and N. Congress Avenue in Kansas City, Platte County, Missouri; and directing the City Clerk to report the termination of the District to the Missouri Department of Economic Development.

Discussion

This Ordinance terminates the existing N.W. 97th Terrace & N. Congress Avenue Community Improvement District. This District was created in August of 2020, but never established a sales tax or other funding source. The District has never provided any services, collected any revenues, made no expenditures, and has no outstanding assets or financial obligations to distribute.

Termination of a District requires that existing assets of a District must be sold or transferred in accordance with a dissolution plan, as approved by this Ordinance. As there were never any assets or revenues accumulated by this District, there are no assets to be included within the dissolution plan.
