## ORDINANCE NO. TMP-2515

Accepting funds allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, FY 2022 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$678,136.00; estimating and appropriating \$678,136in the Justice Assistance Grant Fund; the Jackson County Prosecutor's Office (\$291,598), the City of Grandview (\$14,559), the City of Independence (\$61,030), the City of Raytown (\$14,199) and Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission (\$100,000); designating requisitioning authorities; and directing the City Clerk to file certain documents with the appropriate offices.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Council acknowledge and accept the funds allocated by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance provided under an agreement with the Jackson County Prosecutor's Office, from the 2022 Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$678,136.00.

Section 2. That the revenue in the following account of the 2022 Justice Assistance Grant Fund is hereby estimated in the following amount:

Section 5. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Grandview, in the amount of \$14,559.00. The agreement is approved in substantial form, *as* that on file with the City Clerk.

Section 6. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Independence, in the amount of \$61,032.00. The agreement is approved in substantial form, *as* that on file with the City Clerk.

Section 7. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Raytown, in the amount of \$14,199.00. The agreement is approved in substantial form, as that on file with the City Clerk.

Section 8. That the Director of Neighborhood Services Department is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a Contract with Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission, in the amount of \$100,000.00. The agreement is approved in substantial form, as that on file with the City Clerk.

I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
