Discussion

This settlement resolves the monetary claims of Russell and Barbara Elwood, Judy Holland, Peggy Ross, Alexander Liera, and Broadway-Westport Property, Inc., that stem from the City's denial of counsel to Dominic Biscari in the Westport fire truck crash from December 2021. Settlement is recommended by the Risk Management Committee and the City Attorney.
