Executive Summary

Consenting to the assignment of certain development rights for Block 124; authorizing the City Manager to execute an Amended and Restated Master Development Financing Agreement among the City of Kansas City, Missouri, the Port Authority of Kansas City, Missouri, and Kansas City Live LLC, a Fifth Amendment to Development Agreement with HRB Tax Group, Inc., and an amendment to the Parking, Operation, Maintenance and Easement Agreement with President Development Group Inc. and President Hotel LC.

Discussion

As part of the 1200 Main/South Loop TIF Plan, the City entered into an agreement with HRB tax group to allow for the construction of a 250,000 to 350,000 SF office tower within Block 124. This agreement includes a provision for the City to assist with the construction of parking spaces to serve the office tower. HRB Tax Group subsequently assigned the development rights to Power Tower Block, LLC.

Due to conditions in the office market, Tower Block and KC Live LLC, are in discussions to assign development rights for the property to allow for the construction of a new residential building. This ordinance would authorize the City Manager to consent to the assignment of rights if the parties arrive at an assignment agreement.

In addition, the ordinance authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute an Agreement with KC Live LLC to outline the terms of the proposed development. The ordinance aso authorizes negotiation and execution of a Financing Agreement between the City and PortKC that was previously executed to finance the construction of the project on Block 124.
