## HEALTH SCIENCES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS

TO APPROVE THE HEALTH SCIENCES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OFFICERS AND MAY 1 TO APRIL 30 2023-24 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City Council of Kansas City (the "City Council") approved the Petition to establish the Health Sciences Community Improvement District (the "HSCID") in Ordinance No. 200810 on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2022.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors approved the ByLaws for the Health Sciences Community Improvement District.

WHEREAS, the ByLaws provide for one (1) year terms for the officers of the District, which are currently Margo Quiriconi, Chair; Troy Lillebo, Treasurer; and Niki Donawa, Secretary.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint Niki Donawa Chair of the Board of Directors for a one (1) year term effective April 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to appoint a new Treasurer and a new Secretary as required in accordance with the ByLaws adopted by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors.

WHEREAS, Margo Quiriconi is no longer a resident of the State of Missouri and has therefore tendered her resignation from the Board of Directors, the Board further desires to appoint a successor Director from Children's Mercy Hospital by Consent Resolution to complete her term.

WHEREAS, the Board desires to approve the Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-24, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HEALTH SCIENCES COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THAT:

- 1. The Board hereby appoints Niki Lee Donawa to serve as the Chair of the Board of Directors effective April 1, 2023.
- 2. The Board requests that Children's Mercy Hospital recommend a representative to serve on the Board of Directors to complete the term of Margo Quiriconi.
- 3. Children's Mercy Hospital recommends Jodi Coombs to serve as Treasurer of the Board and that University of Missouri/Kansas City recommends Troy Lillebo to serve as Secretary of the Board.
- 4. The Board hereby appoints Jodi Coombs as Treasurer and Troy Lillebo as Secretary.

5. The Board hereby approves the Budget attached hereto as Exhibit A for the 2023-24 Fiscal Year.
