This Ordinance updates Public Works standards for Section 2200 - Subgrade Preparation Section 2201.3.E – Roll Testing, updating standard drawings curb ramp template SW-1, Updating Standard Drawings Speed Hump TC-SH-1, New Standard Drawings Raised Crosswalk TC-RC-1, New Standard Drawings Raised Intersection TC-RI-1, New Standard Drawings Concrete Alley AS-2-C, New Standard Drawings Concrete Alley AS-2-A.

Discussion

The Standards Change Process was followed:

- 1. Public Works Standards Committee reviews proposed changes
- 2. Public meeting is held to receive public input on proposed changes
- 3. Public comments are received for 30 days immediately following the public meeting
- 4. Standards Committee may then recommend that the changes be approved, approved with modifications, denied, or continued for further consideration
- 5. City Council must make final approval of changes

The Public meeting was held on July 21, 2023. The Public Works Standard Committee voted on January 22, 2024.
