 Resolution of the claim for worker's compensation benefits for Jason B. Orcutt.

Discussion *(including relationship to other Council actions)*

Jason Orcutt was a firefighter who fell from an elevated truck platform and struck the back of his head, causing traumatic brain injury such that he is no longer employable. The City spent \$132,832.25 on medical care. He is now permanently disabled. This ordinance will pay a lump sum of \$74,414.51 in retroactive permanent disability and he will receive \$896.16 per week for the remainder of his life.
