## REGULATION NUMBER 65238 THROUGH 65244 INSTALLATIONS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (b) of Section 70-38 of the “Code of General Ordinances of Kansas City, Missouri” and subject to the provisions thereof, traffic regulations are hereby made and adopted as follows:

**Stopping, Standing and/or Parking** shall be prohibited (as indicated) on the following street(s) and shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-530**:

<b><u>Regulation Number</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Restriction</u></b>
65238	39th Street, south side, from State Line Road then east 50 feet	No Parking Anytime:
65239	Mill Creek Parkway, east side, from Ward Parkway (South Drive) then south 100 feet	No Parking Anytime

**Parking** for longer than the **Time Limit**, as indicated below, during the hours and/or days indicated shall be prohibited. The time limit and effective hours and/or days shall be added to the list as contained in **Section 70-531**:

<b><u>Regulation Number</u></b>	<b><u>Location</u></b>	<b><u>Restriction</u></b>
65240	39th Street, north side, from Terrace Street then west 125 feet	Two Hour Parking 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday

65241	39th Street, south side, from a point 50 feet west of Terrace Street to Wyoming Street	One Hour Parking 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday
65242	39th Street, north side, from Genessee Street then east 90 feet	One Hour Parking 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday
65243	39th Street, south side, from Wyoming Street to Genessee Street	One Hour Parking 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday
65244	39th Street, south side, from a point 50 feet east of State Line Road then east 215 feet	Two Hour Parking 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday through Friday

The locations affected by the above regulations will be marked in accordance with standards prescribed in the “Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways” and said regulations shall become effective five days after publication in The Daily Record.
