Executive Summary

Authorizing a \$13,623,926.21 contract with Ideker, Inc. for the 1L-19R High Speed Connectors project at KCI Airport; authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$14,986,318.83; appropriating \$14,986,318.83 from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Kansas City Airports Fund.

Discussion

THE MWDBE CREO CUP WAS APPROVED FOR 22.35% DBE PARTICIPATION.

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct Runway 1L-19R High Speed Taxiway Connectors at the Kansas City International Airport (MCI). Contractor will remove the surface pavement and underlying pavement layers contributing to the pavement distresses exhibited on the pavement surface and to address the low structural integrity of the existing pavement section. While addressing the existing pavement condition, the project will also realign the exit taxiways in the optimal locations to improve Runway Occupancy Time.

RESOLUTION - Expressing the City Council's support for the City's grant application for the Grand Boulevard Bicycle-Pedestrian Bridge Project in the amount of \$8,532,929.00, which would require local matching funds up to the amount of \$2,133,232.00.

WHEREAS, this project is already included as a part of the City's Capital Improvements Plan and the project status is in the "design complete" phase; and

WHEREAS, this project improves accessibility and infrastructure by providing a bicycle and pedestrian connecting route to the Riverfront that currently does not exist; and

WHEREAS, this project provides an additional transportation option for access to and from the new CPKC Stadium at the Riverfront that is an alternative to automobile use; and

WHEREAS, this project is anticipated to be completed prior to the 2026 World Cup events and will be available as a transportation route for events at the Riverfront; and

WHEREAS, local matching funds are required up to the amount of \$2,133,232.00 for this grant, and this project intends to explore potential "in-kind" sources of local match funds, including right-of-way; NOW, THEREFORE,
