BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of General Services Department is authorized to execute a lease agreement with A K Lee Construction, LLC, for the purpose of the use of an office space beginning August 31, 2021 and ending August 30, 2024.
