BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Olsson Inc. in the amount of \$819,715.00 for design services in the inspection of public improvements for Project No. 89008516 75th & Wornall Road Improvements from funds in Account AL-3524-898016-B-89008516. A copy of the contract is on file in the Director’s office of the Public Works Department.

Section 2. That this ordinance, relating to the design, repair, maintenance or construction of a public improvement, is recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3) (D) of the City Charter and shall take effect in accordance with Section 503, City Charter.
