BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That settlement of the claim of Gregory Scholz for Workers' Compensation benefits against the City of Kansas City, Missouri, for any and all injuries resulting from an accident while employed by the City, as more fully set forth and subject of a formal claim, Injury No. 21-058135, presently pending before the Division of Workers' Compensation of the State of Missouri, by payment to Gregory Scholz of the sum of \$79,363.20, medical closed, as recommended by the City Attorney and Risk Management Committee, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$79,363.20, in settlement of said claim from funds heretofore appropriated in Account No. 24-7020-071402-610400.
