ORDINANCE NO. 210277

Authorizing a \$3,167,000.00 construction contract with Kissick Construction Company, Inc., for the replacement of water mains in the area of Broadway Boulevard to Holmes Road, W. 7th Street to W. 18th Street; and authorizing a maximum expenditure of \$3,500,000.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized to execute Contract No. 9272 in the amount of \$3,167,000.00 with Kissick Construction Company, Inc., for the replacement of water mains in the area of area of Broadway Boulevard to Holmes Road, W. 7th Street to W. 18th Street, Project No. 80002032. A copy of the contract is on file in the office of Water Services.

Section 2. That the Director of the Water Services Department is authorized a maximum expenditure of \$3,500,000.00 from Account No. AL-8077-807705-611060-80002032, Water Main Replacement Program, to satisfy the cost of this contract.

I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
