Wainright on December 21, 1953; his passion for youth development began while living in the Wayne Miner Projects and manifested through service and dedication at the YMCA, Boy Scouts, Rotary Club, The Boys Club and Wayne Miner Sports Teams; and

WHEREAS, Calvin Wainright graduated from Manual High School in 1971 and attended Lon Morris Junior College in Jacksonville, Texas, Lincoln University in Jefferson City, Missouri, and Penn Valley Community College, earning a certification in Youth Development; and

WHEREAS, Calvin was taught the purpose of giving back to his community, as he worked and served at the Greater Kansas City Mental Health Foundation, Minute Circle Friendly House, Kansas City Free Health Clinic, and for many years at Don Bosco, under the leadership of Lou Rose, established the "We Hoop for Peace" a basketball program focused on building up young men, inspiring their dreams and desires to live and be successful.
