Approving and authorizing settlement of the lawsuit entitled *Caitlin Mahr v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2216-CV23594, in the amount of \$85,000.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the payment of the sum of \$85,000.00 for the settlement of claims asserted by Caitlin Mahr in the lawsuit styled *Caitlin Mahr v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2216-CV23594, as recommended by the City Attorney and the Risk Management Committee, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$85,000.00 in settlement of said claims asserted by Caitlin Mahr in this lawsuit from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 24-7010-131521-B, General Liability.
