ORDINANCE NO. 220924

Sponsor: Director of the Aviation Department

Authorizing a Lease Agreement between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, Aviation Department and the United States Government Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Bureau at the New Terminal at Kansas City International Airport.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Aviation is hereby authorized to enter into a Lease Agreement with the United States Government Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Bureau at the Kansas City International Airport. A copy of the agreement is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

Section 2. That the Director of Aviation is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, such documents, contracts, leases, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this ordinance and to implement the transaction(s) contemplated.
