BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Superior Bowen Asphalt Co. in the amount of \$14,421,235.00 for Contract Number CS220038 street resurfacing North of the Missouri River from funds previously appropriated to the following accounts:

AL-3523-897701-B-89008533 Street Preservation \$ 6,666,667.00 23-3090-897701-B-89008533 Street Preservation 7,754,568.00 TOTAL: \$14,421,235.00

Section 2. That the Fairness in Construction Board, to assure fair representation by socially and economically disadvantaged groups, approved for this project, a nine (9) percent representation by Minority Owned Businesses and a seven (7) percent representation by Women Owned Businesses.

Section 3. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into contract changes up to and including thirty percent (30%) of the original contract price for related work. A copy of the contract is on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.

Section 4. That this ordinance, relating to the design, repair, maintenance or construction of a public improvement, is recognized as an ordinance with an accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)
