ORDINANCE NO. 210931

Authorizing Amendment No. 2 in the amount of \$157,700.00 to an agreement with TranSystems Corporation for design services in the inspection of city sidewalks for a total contract amount of \$940,749.25.

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2017, the Council expressed support in a data-driven systematic sidewalk program to prioritize sidewalk inspections and repairs through Committee Substitute for Resolution No. 170516; and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2019, the Council approved Ordinance No. 190287, a design services contract with TranSystems Corporation in the amount of \$568,049.25 for the project; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2020, the Council approved an amendment through Ordinance No. 200850 for a design services contract with TranSystems Corporation in the amount of \$215,000.00 for the project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 2 with TranSystems Corporation in the amount of \$157,700.00 for design services in the inspection of various sidewalks, generally between 20th Street and 48th Street, for a total contract amount of \$940,749.25 from funds previously appropriated to Account No. AL-3522-898077 -B-89022011. A copy of the amendment is on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.
