RESOLUTION - Extending the duration of the Alternatives to Incarceration Commission established in Committee Substitute for Resolution No. 230475 until the Commission completes its work.

WHEREAS, Committee Substitute for Resolution No. 230475 established a commission, ten members to be appointed by the Mayor, to research and recommend to the Mayor and City Council alternatives to incarceration, with the goal of informing the number of jail beds that are needed and to be built by the City in coordination with Jackson County, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the Commission was directed to report to Council within thirty days of the passage of the resolution; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for the Commission and its work; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

That duration of the Alternatives to Incarceration Commission established in Committee Substitute for Resolution No. 230475 shall continue until the Commission completes its work.
