BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute a contract with J.M. Fahey Construction Co. in the amount of \$9,682,940.06 for Contract Number CS220039 street resurfacing Missouri River to 43rd Street from funds previously appropriated to the following accounts:

Section 2. That the Fairness in Construction Board, to assure fair representation by socially and economically disadvantaged groups, approved for this project, a nine (9) percent representation by Minority Owned Businesses and a seven (7) percent representation by Women Owned Businesses.

Section 3. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into contract changes up to and including thirty percent (30%) of the original contract price for related work. A copy of the contract is on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.
