ORDINANCE NO. 230295

Sponsor: Director of the Health Department

Accepting and approving a grant award for a total amount of \$607,200.00 from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to assist with education, surveillance, referrals to programs and resources in an effort to mitigate COVID-19 and help control risk factors for severe disease; estimating and appropriating revenue; and designating requisitioning authority.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That a grant award in the amount of \$607,200.00 between the City of Kansas City, Missouri, acting through its Director of Health, and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, whereby the State will provide funding to assist with education, surveillance, referrals to programs and resources in an effort to mitigate COVID-19 and help control risk factors for severe disease within Kansas City, Missouri for the period beginning February 1, 2023 through January 31, 2024, is hereby accepted and approved. A copy of the grant award agreement, in substantial form, is on file with the Director of Health.

Section 2. That revenue in the following account of the Health Grants Fund is hereby estimated in the following amount:

Section 3. That the sum of \$12,321.76 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the Health Grants Fund in the following account:

23-2480-505077-B-G50507724 Community Health Workers \$12,321.76

Section 4. That the Director of Health is hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$607,200.00 from funds appropriated to Account No. 23-2480-505077-G50507724.

I hereby certify that there is a balance, otherwise unencumbered, to the credit of the appropriation to which the foregoing expenditure is to be charged, and a cash balance, otherwise unencumbered, in the treasury, to the credit of the fund from which payment is to be made, each sufficient to meet the obligation hereby incurred.
