ORDINANCE NO. 210929

Authorizing Amendment No. 3 in the amount of \$200,000.00 to an agreement with Anderson Engineering, Inc. for design services in the inspection of city sidewalks for a total contract amount of \$912,725.00.

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2017, the Council expressed support in a data-driven systematic sidewalk program to prioritize sidewalk inspections and repairs through Committee Substitute for Resolution 170516;

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2019, the Council approved Ordinance No. 190286, a design services contract with Anderson Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$466,225.00 for the project; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2020, the Council approved an amendment through Ordinance No. 200849, for a design services contract with Anderson Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$200,000.00 for the project; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 3 with Anderson Engineering, Inc. for design services in the inspection of various sidewalks, generally between 48th Street and South City Limits, in the amount of \$200,000.00 for with a total contract amount of \$912,725.00 from funds previously appropriated to the following accounts:

That the Civil Rights and Equal Opportunity Department to assure fair representation by socially and economically disadvantaged groups, approved for this project, a thirteen (13) percent representation by Minority Owned Businesses and eight (8) percent representation by Women Owned Businesses for this project.
