## ORDINANCE NO. 211006

Amending Chapter 70, Code of Ordinances, entitled "Traffic and Vehicles," by repealing Section 70-81, Authority of director of public works, and enacting in lieu thereof a new Section 70-81 of like number and subject matter that establishes a policy to address parking and abandoned vehicles throughout the City.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That Chapter 70, Code of Ordinances, entitled "Traffic and Vehicles," is hereby amended by repealing Section 70-81, Authority of director of public works, and enacting in lieu thereof a new 70-81 of like number and subject matter to read as follows:

## Sec. 70-81. Authority of director of public works.

The director of public works acting through the director's delegates is authorized to enforce all ordinances regulating parking and the abandonment of vehicles, articles V and VI of this chapter, within the right-of-way including city-owned parking lots, garages or other properties.
