ORDINANCE NO. 220755

Authorizing the execution of an off-airport parking permit agreement with K.K. Mahadev KCI, Inc., d/b/a Days Inn; and estimating revenue of \$1,200.00 at the Kansas City International Airport.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the Director of Aviation is hereby authorized to execute an Off-Airport Parking Permit Agreement with K.K. Mahadev KCI, Inc., d/b/a Days Inn, at Kansas City International Airport with a term from the effective date of the agreement through to August 31, 2023, with automatic renewal for successive periods of one year each, unless terminated by either party. A copy of the agreement is on file in the Office of the Director of Aviation.

Section 2. That the revenue in following amount of \$1,200.00 is estimated for the initial term in the following account of the Aviation Fund:
