BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the payment of the sum of \$1,500,000.00 for the settlement of claims asserted by Russell and Barbara Elwood, Judy Holland, Peggy Ross, Alexander Llera, and Broadway-Westport Property, Inc., in the lawsuit styled *Russell Elwood, et al. v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2216-CV26061, as recommended by the City Attorney and the Risk Management Committee, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$1,500,000.00 in settlement of said claims asserted by Russell and Barbara Elwood, Judy Holland, Peggy Ross, Alexander Llera, and Broadway-Westport Property, Inc., in this lawsuit from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 24-7010-131521-B, General Liability.
