Approving and authorizing settlement of a lawsuit entitled *Rebecca Reynolds v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2316-CV16772 consolidated with Case No. 2416-CV09409 and Charge No. E-12/23-55824, in the amount of \$1,300,000.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the payment of the sum of \$1,300,000.00 for the settlement of claims asserted by Rebecca Reynolds in the lawsuit styled *Rebecca Reynolds v. City of Kansas City, Missouri*, Case No. 2316-CV16772 consolidated with Case No. 2416-CV09409 and Charge No. E-12/23-55824, as recommended by the City Attorney and the Risk Management Committee, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$1,300,000.00 in settlement of said claims asserted by Rebecca Reynolds in this lawsuit and charge from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 25-7010-131543-B, Public Official Liability Fund.
