ORDINANCE NO. 220995

Sponsor: Director of the Law Department

Reducing the Contingent Appropriation by \$1,839,572.00 in the General Fund; appropriating the amount of \$1,839,572.00 to the City Legal Expense Fund; authorizing the City Attorney to engage in the resolution of the following cases: *Elwood, et al v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, et al.*, Case No. 2216-CV01501; *Holland v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, et al.*, Case No. 2216-CV03284; and *Broadway-Westport Property, Inc. v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, et al.*, Case No. 2216-CV06913; and recognizing this ordinance as having an accelerated effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KANSAS CITY:

Section 1. That the appropriation in the following account of the General Fund is reduced by the following amount:

23-1000-179990-B Contingent Appropriation \$1,839,572.00

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,839,572.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the General Fund to the following account:

23-1000-129998-X- Transfer to City Legal Expense \$1,839,572.00

907010 Fund

Section 3. That the revenue in the following account of the City Legal Expense Fund is hereby estimated in the following amount:

23-7010-120000-501000 Transfer from the General \$1,839,572.00 Fund

Section 4. That the sum of \$1,839,572.00 is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Fund Balance of the City Legal Expense Fund to the following:

23-7010-131545-B-618200 Auto Liability Claims \$1,839,572.00

Section 5. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to resolve the following cases for the sum of \$1,839,572.00 from funds previously appropriated in Account No. 23-7010-131545-B-618200: *Elwood, et al v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, et al.*, Case No. 2216-CV01501; *Holland v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, et al.*, Case No. 2216-CV03284; and *Broadway-Westport Property, Inc. v. City of Kansas City, Missouri, et al.*, Case No. 2216-CV06913.

Section 6. That this ordinance, because it appropriates money, is recognized as an ordinance with accelerated effective date as provided by Section 503(a)(3)(C) of the City Charter and shall take effect accordance with Section 503(a)(1) of the City Charter.
